Sermon: "Calamity" Text: Isaiah 15-16 Terry McIntosh

Introduction: The 21st Century thus far has been a century of calamity. It has been, and is again today, a difficult and perplexing time. How should we view such things as this? Are they the wrath of God? And if the wrath of God, should we be doing anything to mitigate them or extend relief to victims? Answers to questions like these will shape our view as to what God is like, and what we should be like in these times. Note three truths in terms of God, calamity, and us.

I. The of calamity is God (15:9; 16:10)
II. God's heart in calamity is (15:5; 16:9-11) - Some say of this passage that the compassion and emotion is only on the part of Isaiah and not God. Note four reasons this is a flawed view:
