Introduction: In Isa. 52:13-53:12, we have identified four main truths (which I have called "hinges"), upon which eternal salvation swings. These four truths communicate the Servant of the Lord's sacrifice to us. The third hinge, which we want to examine today is:

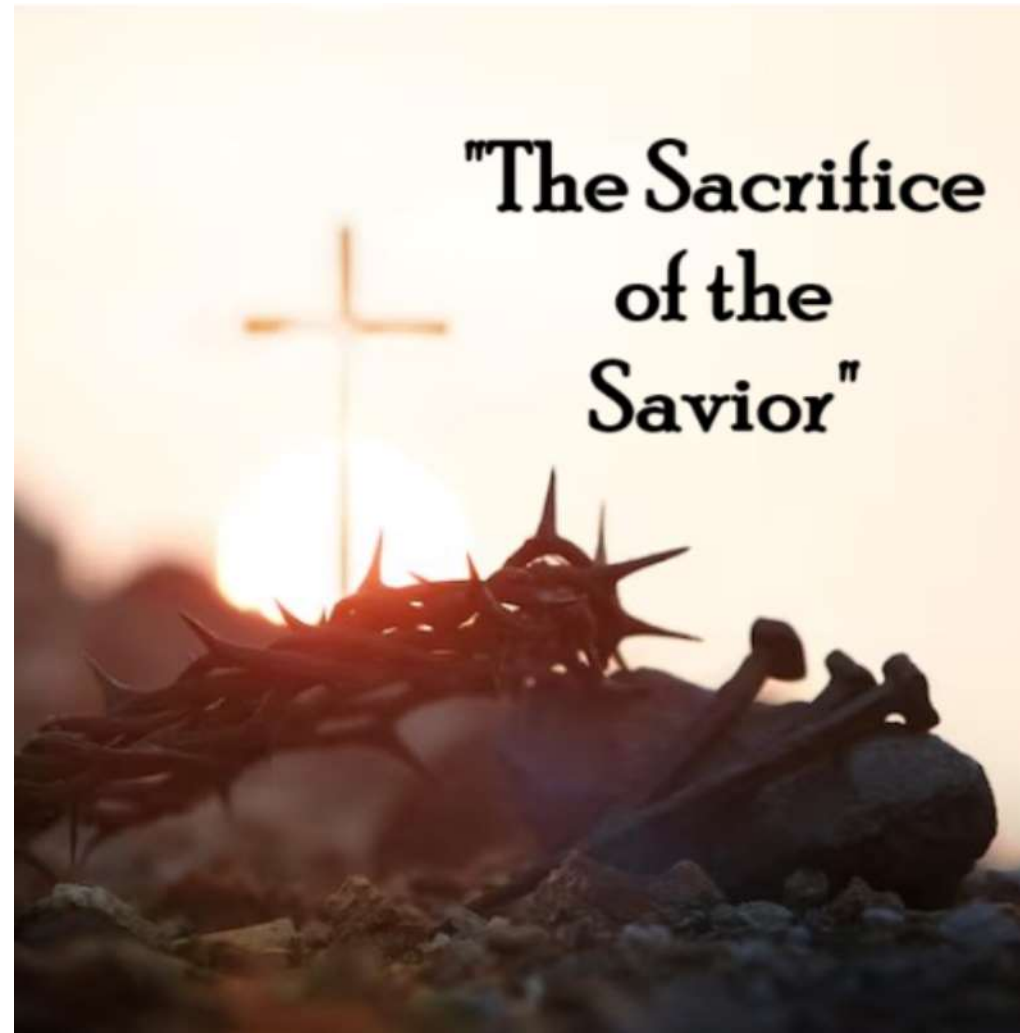
